What is the I.M.P.A.C.T. Leadership Training?

The I.M.P.A.C.T. Leadership Training is a program that provides training to people with disabilities. The purpose of this training is to provide others who have disabilities with greater self-esteem, confidence, and leadership skills. The series is a 7 week course. The classes are led by a lead trainer and a support trainer. Each class is held once a week for one hour via Zoom.

What does this training offer?

Students who attend the I.M.P.A.C.T. Leadership Training will be able to:

- Build new friendships
- Develop leadership skills
- Learn about self-advocacy
- Become familiar with their rights
- Develop public speaking skills

Students interested in the training should:

- Have a developmental or intellectual disability
- Be committed to attending all classes
- Motivated to fully participate in class activities
- Driven to complete homework assignments
